The Value:

The NJ Home Care and Hospice PAC (NJHCH PAC) supports legislators who support home care and hospice services. Our PAC contributions are most productive when they are working in sync with home care and hospice providers involved in the political process who are providing care to the legislators' constituents.

Having a strong PAC allows the Home Care Association of NJ to effectively advocate the home care and hospice message within a very competitive environment.

Who May Contribute to the NJ Home Care and Hospice PAC?

Voluntary contributions may be accepted from U.S. citizens or individuals who are admitted for permanent residence (holders of a "green card"). For-profit corporations may also contribute. Partnerships, LLPs, and LLCs may not contribute as entities, but a contribution may be drawn on the account of a partnership, LLP, or LLC and is treated as a personal contribution by the partner or member who signs the check or written interest. Contributions from 501(c)(3) organizations cannot be accepted. Employees of the Home Care Association of NJ's member organizations can contribute to the NJHCH PAC.

Further, the NJ Home Care and Hospice PAC may only accept individual contributions in the form of a personal check or credit card. All funds are raised through personal contributions, applicable agency contributions and special fundraising activities. All funds are required by law to be set aside in a special bank account, governed by the NJ Home Care and Hospice PAC Board of Directors, which submits quarterly reports to the NJ Election Law Enforcement Commission.

Tax Treatment: NJHCH PAC is a voluntary, non-profit entity formed solely for political purposes. NJHCH PAC is not affiliated with any political party, candidate, or organization. The cost of organization, administration and solicitation of contributions for NJHCH PAC is borne entirely by NJHCH PAC and the Home Care Association of New Jersey. Copies of NJHCH PAC reports are filed with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission. Contributions to the PAC are strictly voluntary and will be used for political purposes to support state candidates. Making a contribution is not a condition of membership in the Home Care Association of NJ. You may refuse to participate at any time without suffering reprisal. Payments of contributions to the NJ Home Care and Hospice PAC are not tax deductible for income tax purposes. Contributions must be made with a person or entity's own funds and cannot be reimbursed.

Contribution Guidelines: Under NJ campaign-finance law, an individual may contribute up to \$7,200 per year to the NJHCH PAC. A corporation may contribute up to \$7,200 per year to the NJHCH PAC.
